I am writing to share with you that Daemen College history will be made tonight as our women's volleyball team becomes the first Daemen team in any sport to compete in a NCAA Division II National Championship event.

Qualifying for an NCAA Championship event is an accomplishment in and of itself, and this distinction is further magnified by the fact that the NCAA selected Daemen College to host the event. Over the next three days, the O'Connell Lumsden Gymnasium will be the site of seven matches over the next three days from eight NCAA member schools (American International University, LeMoyne College, New York Institute of Technology, Adelphi University, University of New Haven, Philadelphia University and Post University) will compete to determine the East Region representative in the national quarterfinals. The estimated economic impact of the event on the local economy is three million dollars. Daemen will receive revenue through concessions sales and increased corporate sponsor interest.

I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate the Women's Volleyball student athletes as well as Head Coach, Stephanie Alban and Assistant Coaches Kaley Vasquez Regan ('14) and Donnie Gleason.
